

# Japanese Urological Association International Foundation Scholarship for Young Asian Urologists



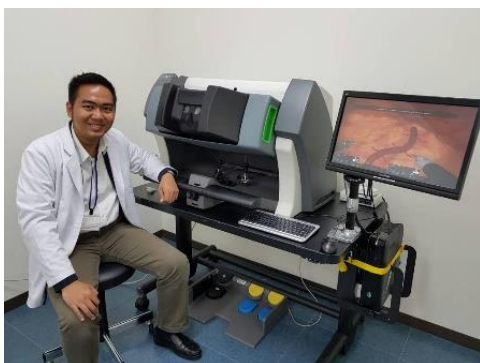
