3. Weather in Seoul

Korea's climate is characterized by four distinct seasons: spring, summer, fall, and winter. In September, which is when the congress is to take place, summer will have been just ended and the weather will be cool. The average daytime temperature of October is usually around $14.4\,^{\circ}\text{C}$.
