ABOUT THE CONVENER



As a long term member of the European Society of Urogenital Radiology (ESUR), the potential for Prostate Imaging was immediately realised by A/Prof Rajeev Jyoti when 3.0T MRI became readily available.

After carefully considering results of clinical trials, and recognising that there is no other means of effectively imaging the prostate, A/Prof Jyoti sought to introduce a state of the art MRI imaging facility in ACT in 2012.

Whilst Prostate MRI is available at some other sites, there are few radiologists with significant experience in reading high volumes of prostate exams. Given the complexity of Multi-Parametric Prostate MRI, education surrounding the reading of these examinations is in high demand.

A/Prof Jyoti has performed over 2000 diagnostic reads, and performed 500 MRI guided Prostate Biopsies at Universal Medical Imaging, Canberra, establishing himself as one of the most experienced Prostate MRI Radiologists in the Southern Hemisphere.

This has resulted in many patients travelling interstate to ACT, to receive the most appropriate management.

Working in consultation with other Prostate Imaging Specialists from Europe, A/Prof Jyoti convened and sold out the First Asia Pacific Prostate MRI Course in 2014. Following the success of this event, a repeat is now planned for Melbourne 2015.

A/Prof Jyoti continues to remain active in the clinical and research arenas to ensure that the latest developments are integrated into the Prostate MRI Course.
