Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand (USANZ) Trainee Week, Sunday, 17th November 2019 to Thursday, 21st November 2019, Brisbane, Australia

The Urological Society of Australia and New Zealand (USANZ) in conjunction with the Board of Urology of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons would like to invite **FOUR SENIOR UROLOGICAL REGISTRARS/RESIDENTS** to attend the USANZ Trainee Week from Sunday, 17th November 2019 to Thursday, 21st November 2019 to be held at Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Brisbane, Australia.

Trainee Week is hosted by a different Training Region each year and the clinical program is developed by the Convenor in consultation with their local Training Committee. The program may include some aspects of skills training (where available) together with exam practice and interactive clinical sessions.

This year, the Convenor of Trainee Week is Dr Malcom Lawson, Chair, Queensland Regional Training Committee.

The terms of sponsorship for the four successful senior registrars/residents in Urology would be:

- UAA will pay up for the air travel **up to S\$1,000 (Singapore Dollars : One Thousand Only)** and visa application (if any) for each senior registrar/resident attending.
- USANZ will pay for all registration fees and accommodation (single room) at Rydges South Bank – checking in on Saturday, 16th November 2019, and checking out on Thursday, 21st November 2019 (5 nights). Additional nights can be arranged but the cost will be on personal account.

Please note that USANZ **will be** providing airport transfers. All successful nominees are required to arrive by Saturday, 16th November 2019 and can depart on Thursday, 21st November 2019 (the programme will finish at 1600 hrs on 21st November 2019).

UAA will select the **four Senior Registrars/Residents** from the 25 (excluding USANZ) Member Nations based on the following criteria:

- 1) The nominees should be currently undertaking urological training and **must be** Senior Residents grade and **have not yet** completed their urological training.
- 2) The nominee must send in **an essay** of not more than 1000 words on ‘**How would I view my future in the path of Urology? This is a mandatory requirement.**’
- 3) Submit curriculum vitae (together with a recent photograph (mandatory) in the word document format as per attached in typewritten form.
- 4) The nominee must be nominated/supported by the National Association, endorsed by the President or Secretary via email (See template). Direct submission by individuals will be rejected.
- 5) The nominee must be fluent in spoken English
- 6) The nominee must apply as a UAA Individual Member (Membership Form attached)

Each Member Nation can only send in ONE nominee for selection. Selection criteria will be based on order of merit and suitability. UAA reserves the right to reject any nominee which does not meet the above criteria.

Please send in your nomination to Ms Angie See, Executive Secretary at angie.see.b.g@sgh.com.sg **by 31st August 2019 or earlier.** An acknowledgement note will be sent upon receipt. There will be no further extension.

Please note that the successful nominees will each have to write a training report to UAA within one month upon completion of the program. A sample template is attached.

UAA will only reimburse the airfare and visa application (if any) upon receipt of the training report within one month upon completion of the course with all the relevant supporting documents (airfare/visa receipts and boarding pass) for the reimbursement.
